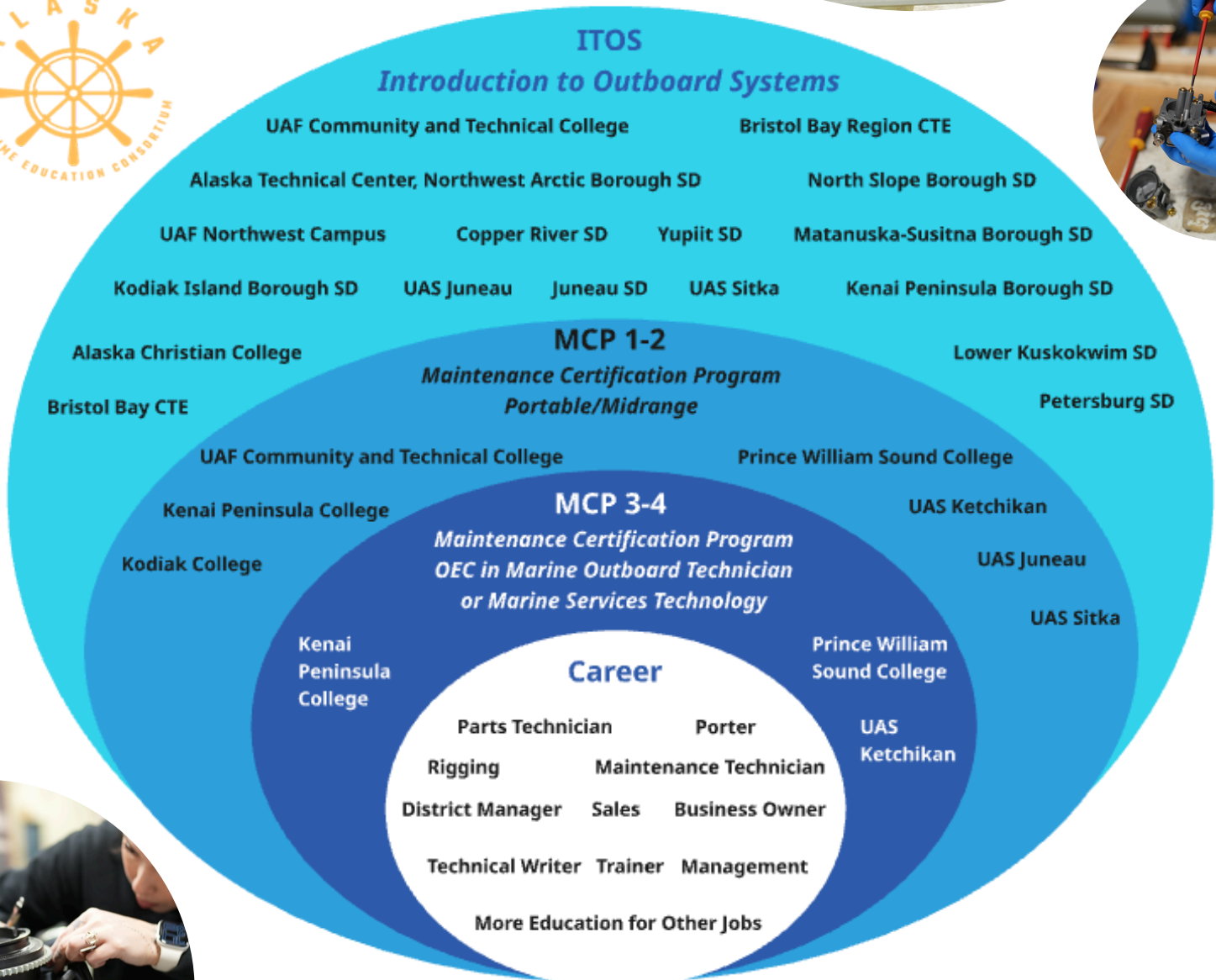

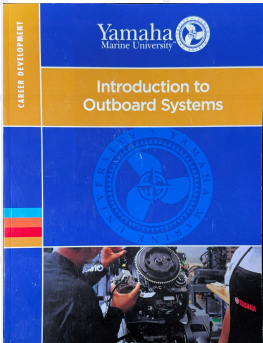

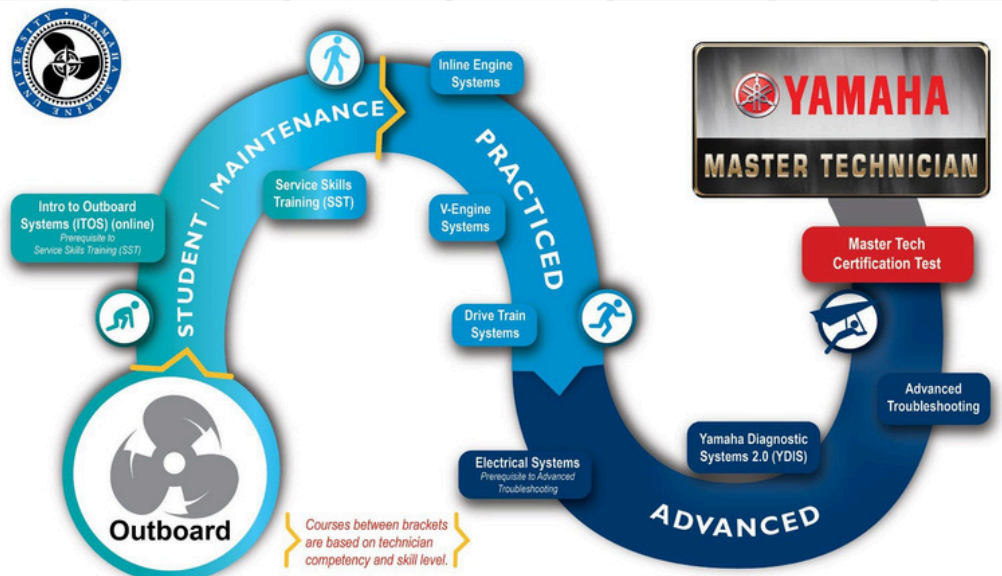


Students begin the training program with an online course, Introduction to Outboard Systems (ITOS)

The curriculum then progresses through MCP levels 1-4, which do not have to be taken in order.

These courses combine theoretical instruction with hands-on laboratory training, covering concepts, operations, service, and maintenance of 2-stroke and 4-stroke outboard engines.

The Alaska Maritime Education Consortium Partners and Affiliates will hold these courses in a variety of structures; intensives, weekend or evening courses, semester-long, etc. Please refer to the diagram on the front page for more information about which courses are offered where.
