

# Training Guide for North Slope Travel & Work

This guide outlines the *minimum* training required to travel and work at ConocoPhillips Alaska assets on the North Slope. Training requirements are based on whether personnel are Escorted / Visitors or Unescorted, as defined below. Additional training is necessary depending on the nature of the task being performed. Contact your sponsor, supervisor, or local Safety Specialist if you have any questions about training needs.

Unescorted	Escorted / Visitors
Personnel who travel to the North Slope to perform physical work without being escorted, regardless of location and crew size.	Personnel who travel to the North Slope for various reasons (audit, meeting, tour, etc.) but are not involved with physical work activity are considered visitors. If visitors leave the main camp area, they must always be escorted by a person who is fully trained.  or Personnel who travel to the North Slope to perform physical work regardless of location while being escorted by a person who is fully trained.

2. HSE Orientation applies to all locations where individual is staying or working. First time workers need to email completion certificate to: [akhseorientation@conocophillips.com](mailto:akhseorientation@conocophillips.com) (replaces Welcome to Alpine, Kuparuk Camp Orientation, Alpine Runway, North Slope Radio)
3. HSE Awareness applies to all locations where individuals are staying or working. (Replaces Hazwoper First Responder Awareness, Energy Isolation Awareness, Hydrogen Sulfide and Hazard Communication)
4. ODPCP & Environmental Awareness also applies to all locations (Replaces ODPCP/SPCC and NPR-A Orientation)
5. Additional courses such as PrepAlaska and our Incident-Free Culture Course (IFC) may be required upon arrival at our locations.

## Lower 48 Equivalency

Basic Orientation Plus (BOP) or Safety Essentials ONLY when completed with North Slope Orientation (online available through Alaska Safety Alliance) will be accepted by North Slope Operators.
